MURDOCK CANAL TRAIL

The original Murdock Canal was built in the early 1900s to provide water from the Provo River for irrigation in Northern Utah County.

During 2011-2012, the Provo River Water Users Association enclosed the canal in a 10.5' diameter steel pipe, which allowed for the construction of the Murdock Canal Trail. The Association, Utah County, and Mountainland Association of Governments worked together closely to fund and build what is the 'Crown Jewel' in the county trail system.
